These trends are also evident in individual WLS member library profiles that include detailed community, collection, activity, and financial data.

Executive Summary

The *WLS Member Library Statistics 2024* report leverages information from the *Annual Reports for Public & Association Libraries 2024* submitted to the New York State Division of Library Development by member libraries. This year's report provides systemwide trends, key for strategic planning and decision-making, as well as individual library profiles that highlight the connection between a library's community and its resources; the latter may also serve as standalone resources.

Most Library Staffing Supports Slow Community Growth

Library service areas saw small population gains during the last decade, and most libraries maintained staffing levels to match the growth. Three libraries had greater than 10% drops in staffing levels from 2023 based on full-time equivalent reporting, which may be part of an industry-wide trend to shift from full-time to part-time positions.

Collections Evolve to Meet Community Needs

Libraries have responded to community needs in several ways, including addressing affordability challenges in today's economic climate. This includes:

- Libraries have responded to changes in community needs by shifting media resources from physical formats to digital and streaming services.
- Libraries added variety to their physical formats, including "Library of Things" items that patrons need but may not use frequently enough to purchase, from cake pans and extension cords to telescopes and outdoor learning kits.
- Circulating passes to museums, purchased by libraries from partnering museums, are another resource made available to patrons that improve cultural and social literacy.

Circulation Shifts Further to Online Use, Libraries Expand On-Site Programs

In 2024, Westchester Library System member libraries continued to show growth related to post-pandemic circulation and activities, with overall higher rates of physical item circulation, programs, and program attendance.

- Use of electronic resources remained higher by far than pre-pandemic levels.
- In addition to traditional story times, book groups, and music programs, many Westchester libraries have included skill-building programs like financial and civic literacy, cultural programs featuring chefs from other countries, and recreational programs that provide social engagement like gaming for teens and mahjong for adults.

Strategic Planning Requires Funding Analysis

Although funding remained stable for most libraries in 2024, increasing to meet NYS Minimum Standards, strategic analysis of resource use and funding streams will be essential as libraries respond to evolving budgetary changes at all levels of government, at partnering affiliates, and for individual supporters; increasing needs for facility maintenance and repair; and increased community information and technology needs.

Population Served

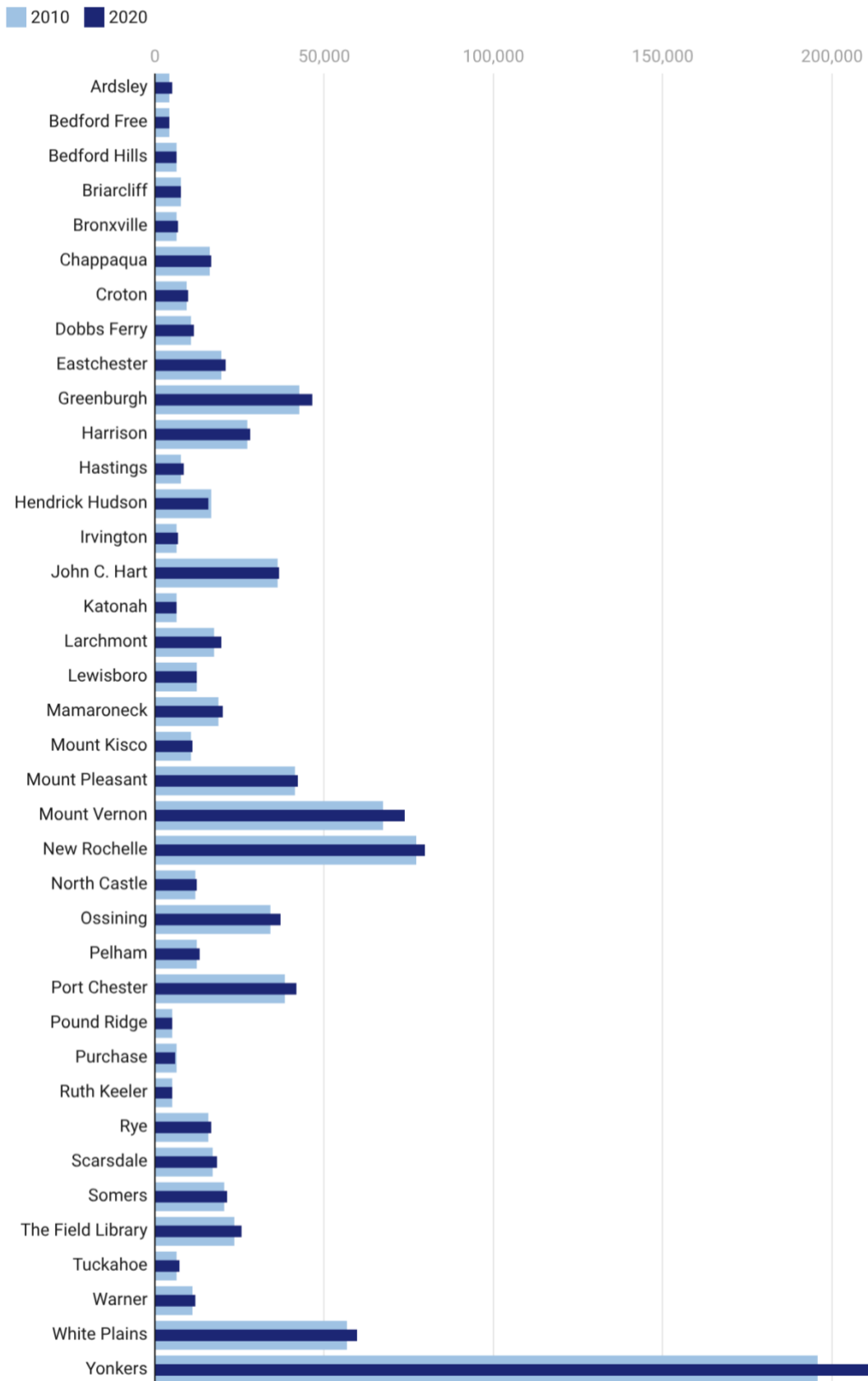
The population served is based on Department of Library Development (DLD) population counts according to the most current library-chartered service area documents in each library's charter file and local unchartered service areas that the library contracts to serve. This largely stable indicator can help the library gauge and respond to community needs.

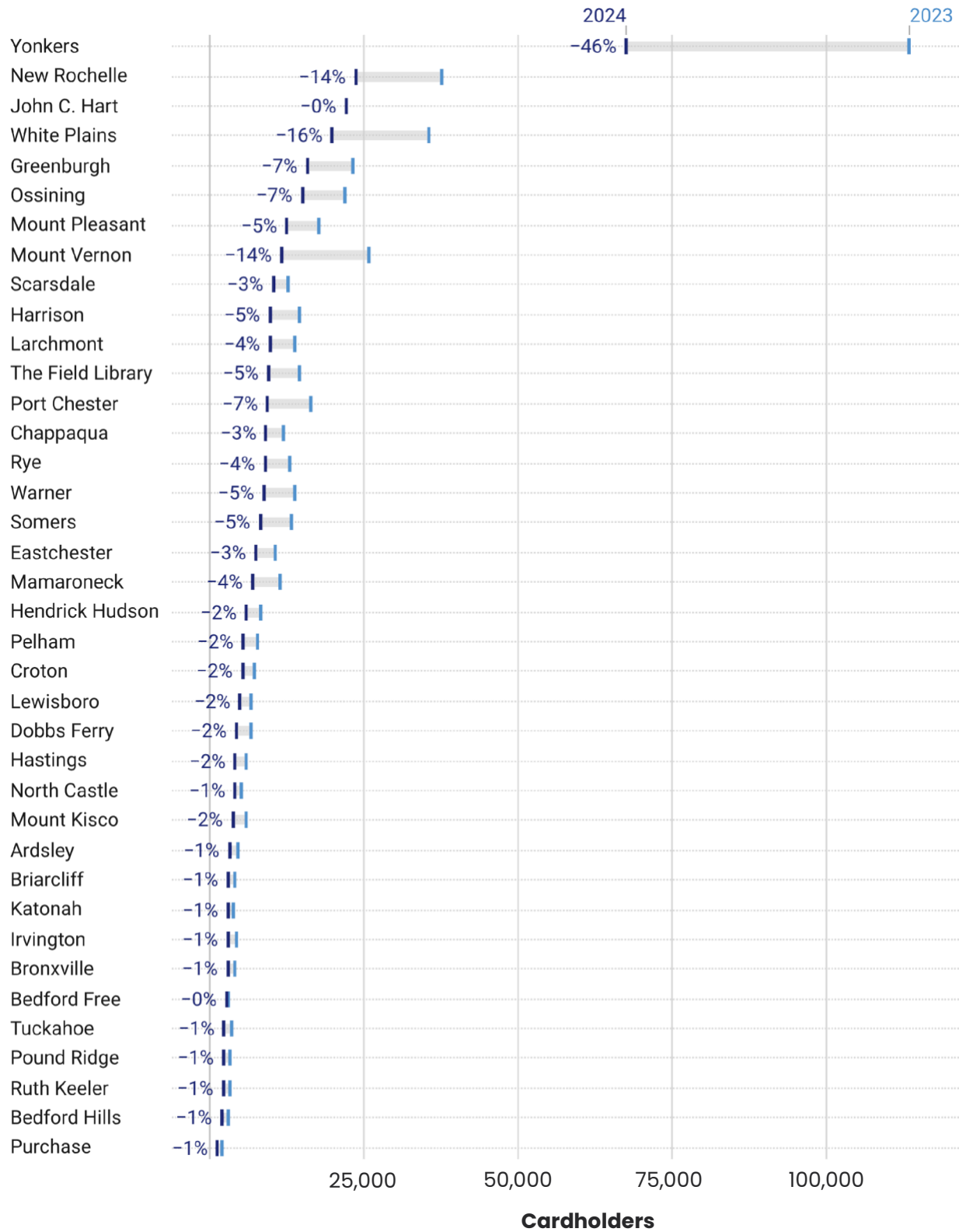
Library Cardholders

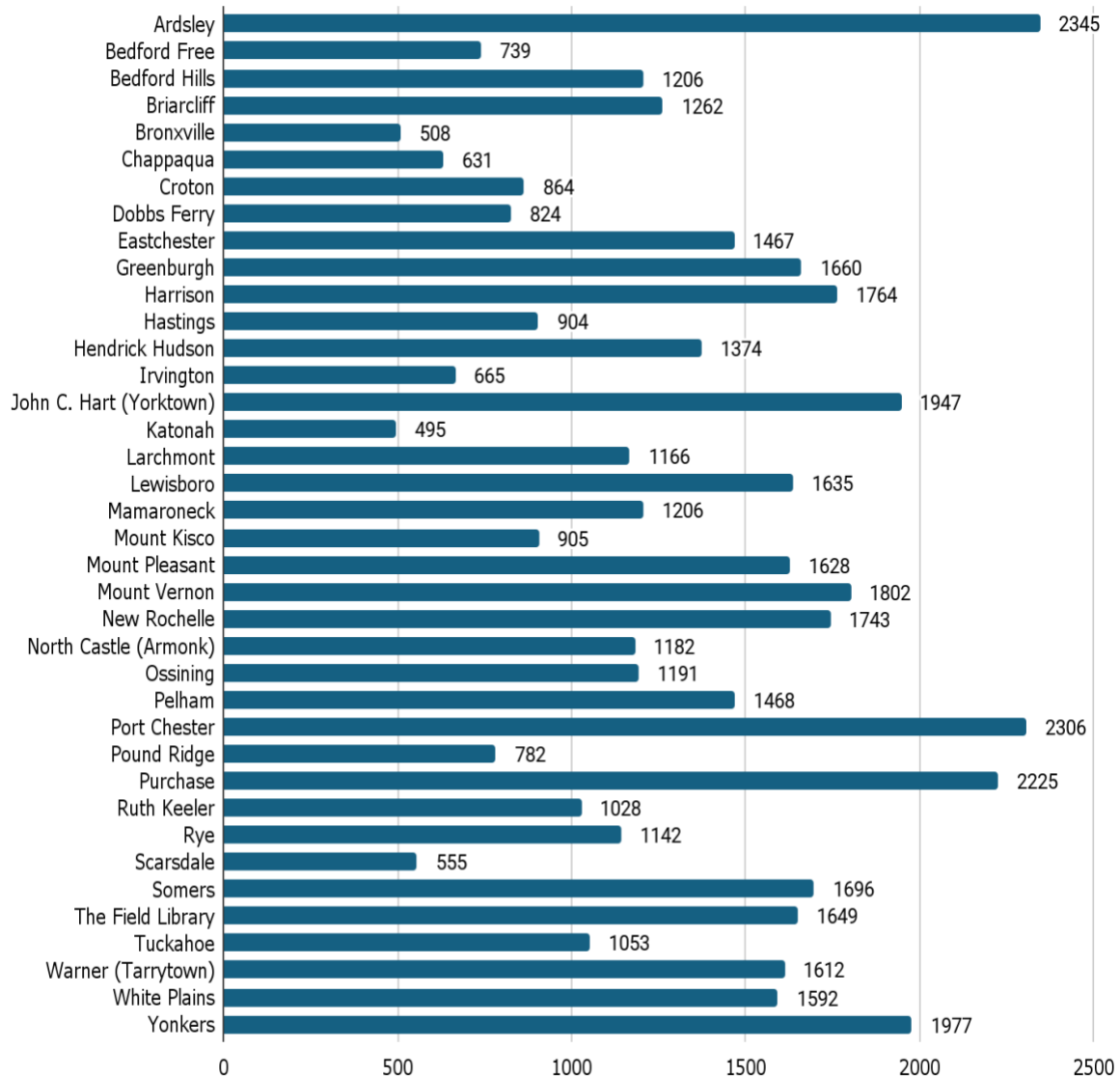
From Purchase, which has 2.70 FTEs, to Yonkers, which has 107 FTE's, the size of a library's staff reflects the size of its community and its cardholders.

Staff Per Population Served

On average, each staff person serves 1,324 members of their population. Individual library counts may be most affected by household income and funding structure and less so by the size or location of the community.



Trustees

Each library is governed by written bylaws which define the structure and governing functions of its library board of trustees. In 2024, Westchester library boards ranged in size from 5 - 24. The average board had 9 members.

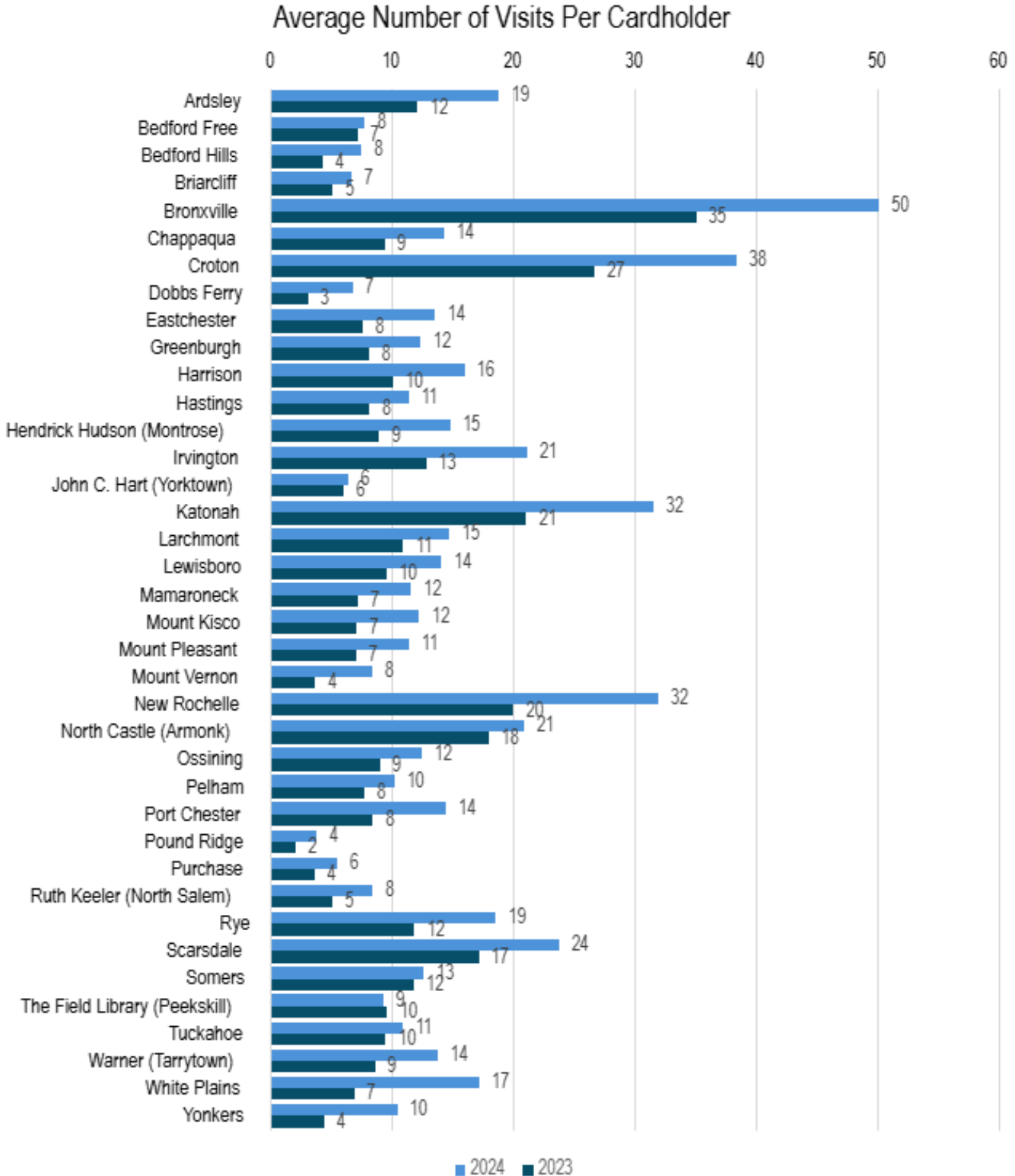

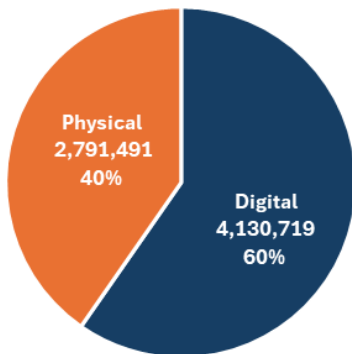

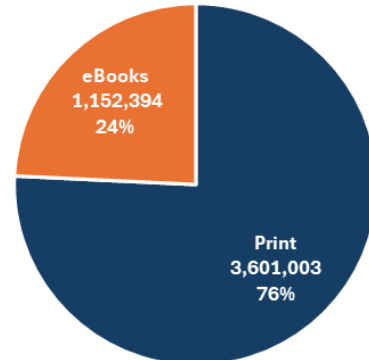
Total Circulation

Westchester library patrons still prefer checking out physical items over digital ones, and book circulation drives that trend. Like the majority of Americans who read, for Westchester patrons there's no substitute for holding a print book in their hands.

Physical and Digital Circulation Comparison

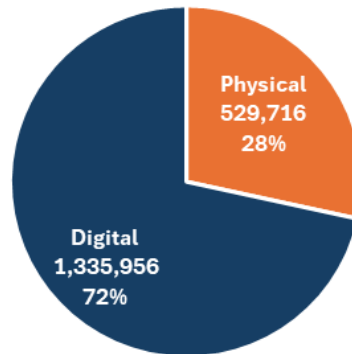


Print and Digital Book Circulation

Physical and Digital Media Circulation



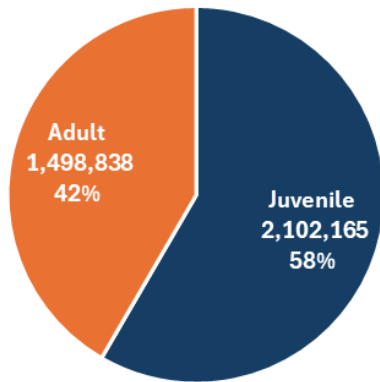
Over 4 million physical items were checked out of Westchester libraries in 2024 – an average of 36 items every hour libraries are open - and circulation of physical items has returned to the incremental annual growth seen prior to the pandemic. While physical circulation increased 1.99% from 2023 totals, it still shows a significant 46.67% gain from 2021, when patrons and libraries were recovering from pandemic conditions.

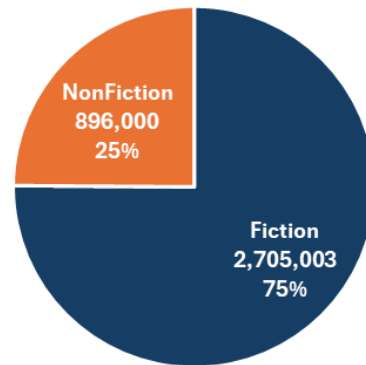
Book Circulation

Storytimes continue to be the most consistently attended programs, driving the checkouts of juvenile books. At all age levels, fiction far outweighs nonfiction circulation. Nonfiction circulation is less than half of what it was ten years ago; in the 2014 Annual Report, libraries reported that Westchester patrons checked out almost 2 million nonfiction books – 1,950,155 to be exact.

Target Audience Book Circulation

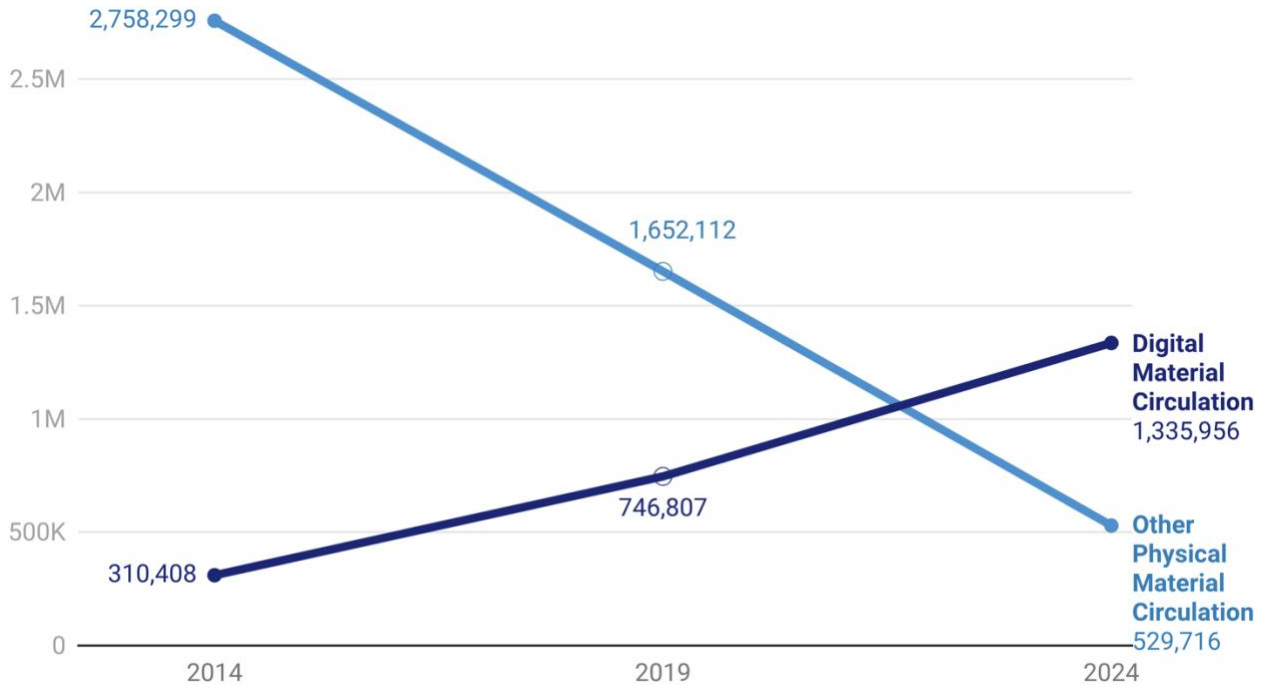


Fiction and Nonfiction Circulation



Non-Book Material Circulation

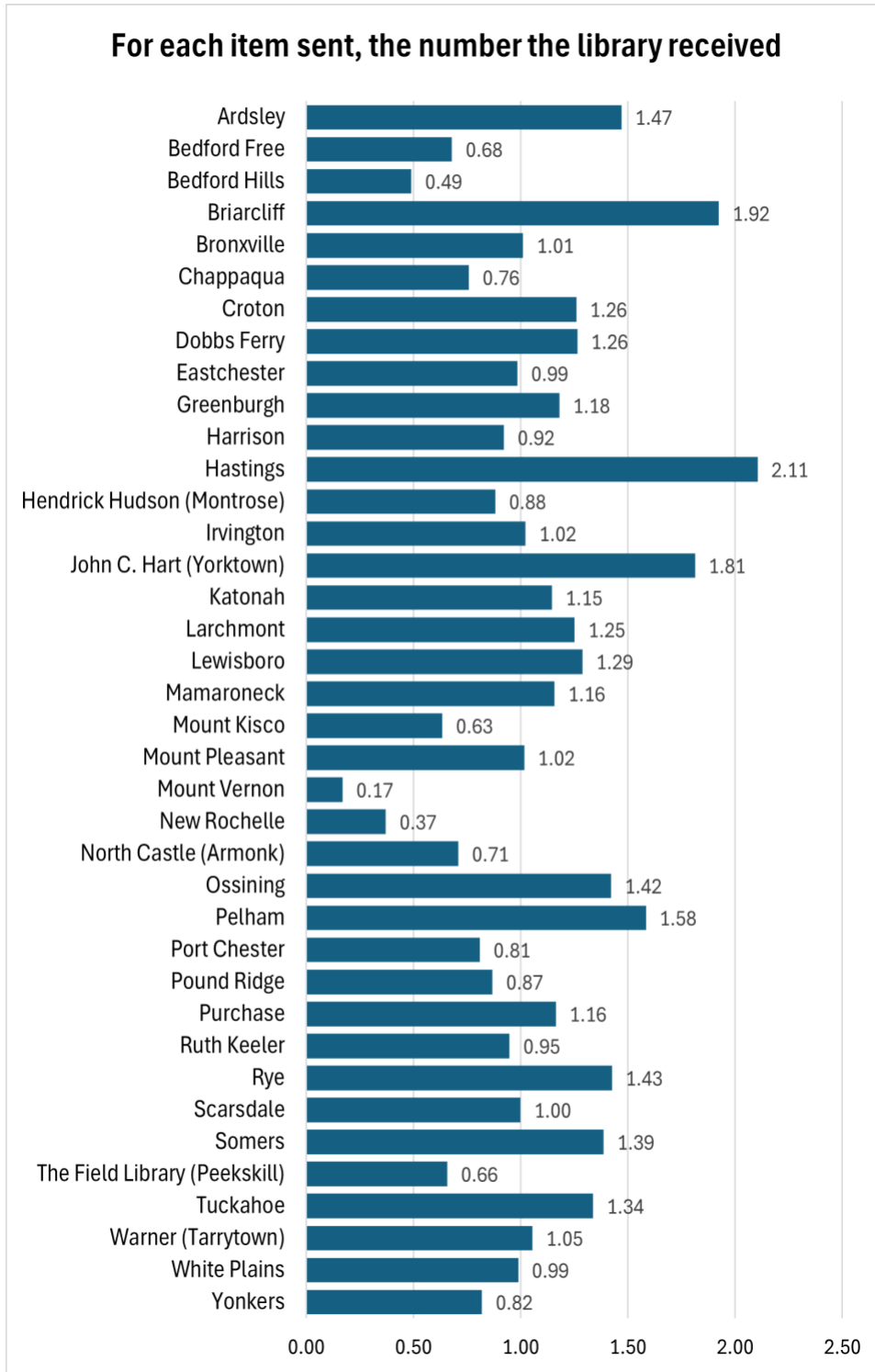
As we've seen, digital media circulation was one and a half times more than physical non-print circulation, the majority of which is audiobook, music CD and DVD circulation. This difference is evident in circulation changes over the last 10 years, during which it has declined by over 75%. In contrast, circulation of digital audiobooks, music, and video has increased over 400%.

Interloans

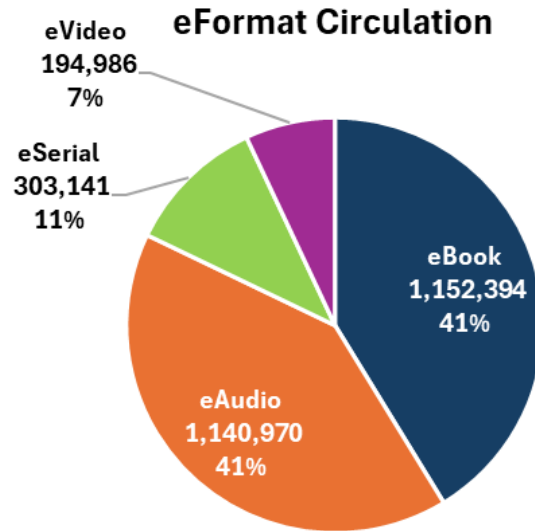
Westchester libraries shared over 1.2 million items with each other and with libraries outside the county, through WLS Interlibrary Loan, to respond to patron needs as quickly as possible. Collection size is the most common factor for differences in whether libraries provide or receive materials. However, on average, there is close to equity in library materials sharing.

EMaterials Circulation

The majority of electronic materials circulation is eBook and eAudio formats. Together they are an equal share of all electronic materials circulated. Other formats, eSerial and eVideo, are a smaller share, likely reflecting the availability of video streaming providers and access to periodicals via standalone digital apps.



Reference Transactions

Across the county, the post-pandemic increase in reference transactions from 2023 (4.34%) reflects the return of patrons to libraries in other areas like visits (7.26%).

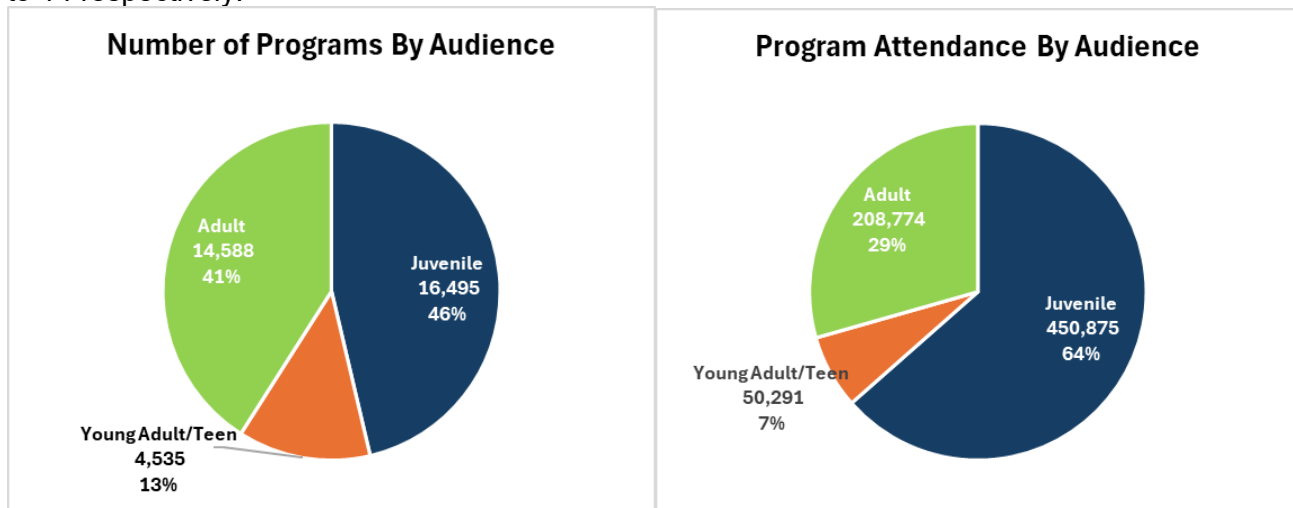

Library Programs

Most libraries increased the number of programs they offered from 2023, leading to a countywide increase (11.7%); most libraries that did not hold more programs reported unusual circumstances including building maintenance issues or staffing shortages. Not surprisingly, program attendance increased at a similar rate (11.30%).

Programs By Age Group

Westchester libraries offer programming for patrons of all ages. Programs for children 0-11 years old are in high demand; they represent both the largest proportion of programs and they are intended for the largest number of attendees. Attendance is almost double that of adult attendance, on average 27 to 14 respectively.



Literacy Programs

Literacy programs are the foundation of the lifelong learning opportunities that patrons can pursue at libraries: 95% of Westchester libraries offer early literacy programs for ages 0-5 and their parents, 63% offer adult literacy programs, 47% offer English As a Second Language programs, and 82% offer digital literacy programs.

One-to-One Sessions

Libraries offered to meet individual patrons for a variety of services: language literacy, digital literacy, services to the homebound, and homework assistance and tutoring. In addition, many assembled project kits with materials and instructions that patrons took home. Over 44,000 patrons benefited from these services, 46.19% more than in 2023.

Public Internet

Westchester patrons used the internet at libraries over 1.4 million times in 2024, and wireless use accounted for most of it (57.17%). The 12.23% increase over 2023 was driven by a 30.66% increase in public PC use, which may be a response to more employers and government agencies requiring online applications.

Operating Receipts

All but two Westchester libraries saw modest increases in operating receipts from 2023 to 2024, ranging from Irvington's 7.41% decrease to Scarsdale's 45.12% increase, and an average 6.82% increase overall.

Local Public Support

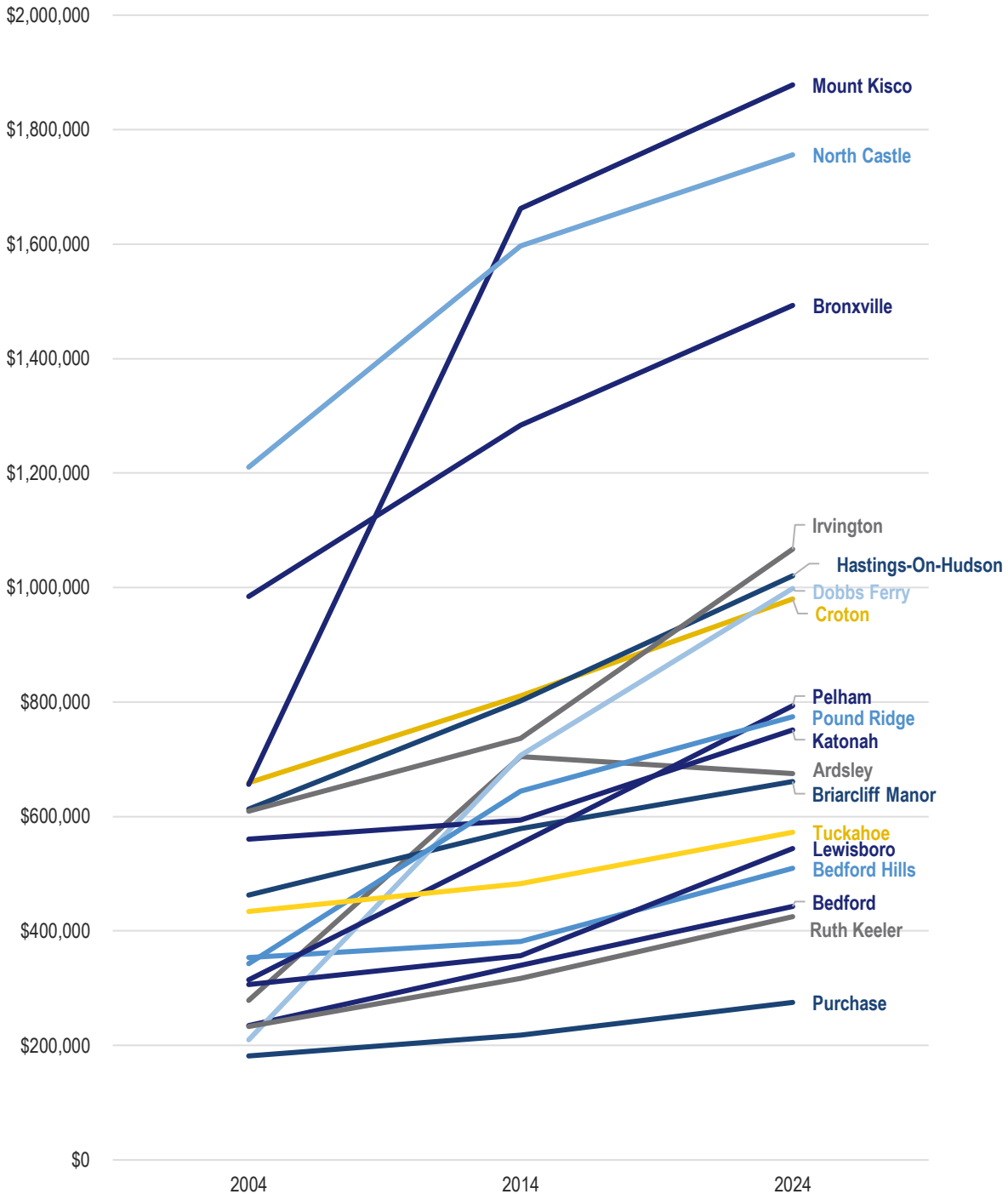

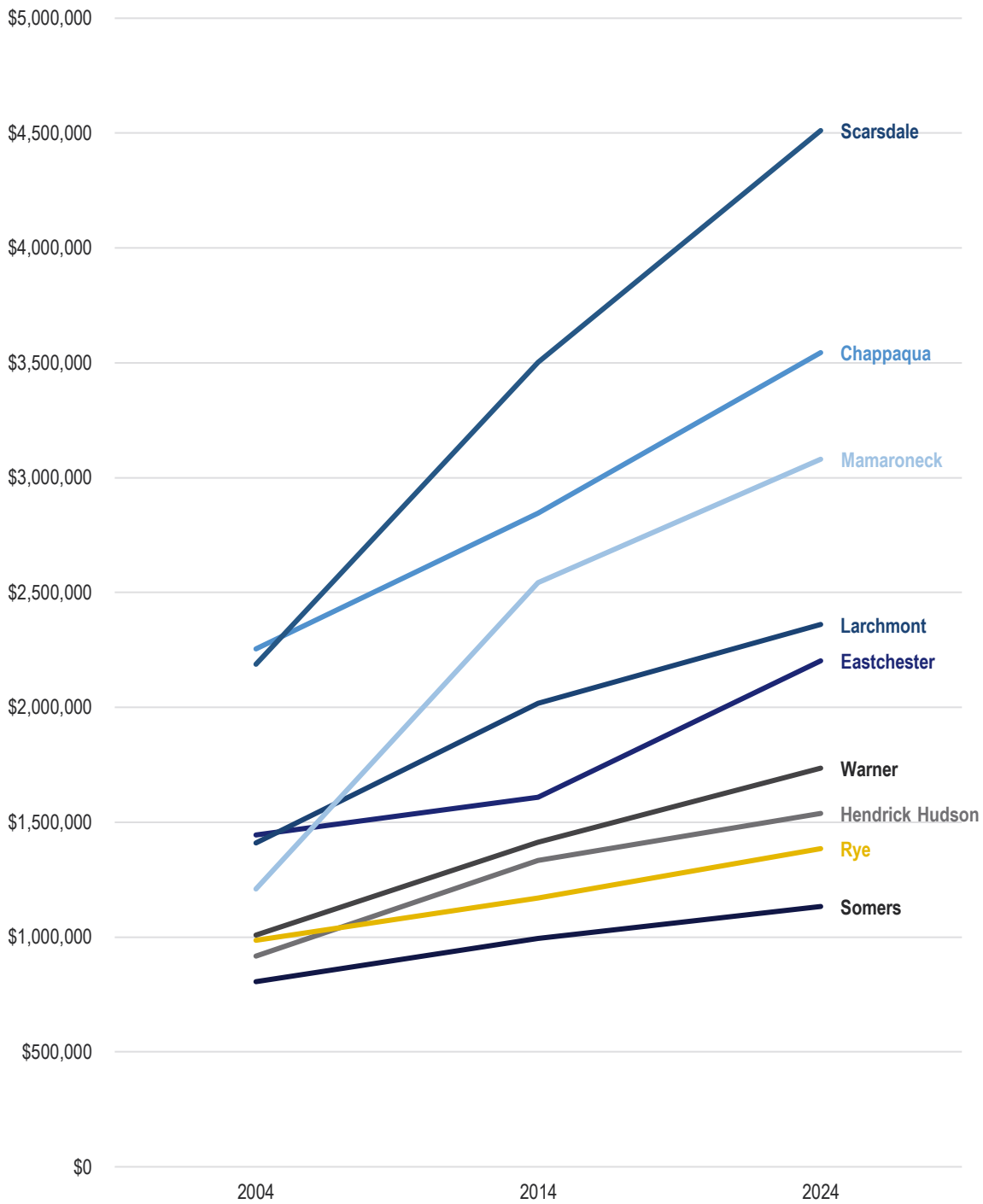

Total Local Support, Service Populations Less than 10,000



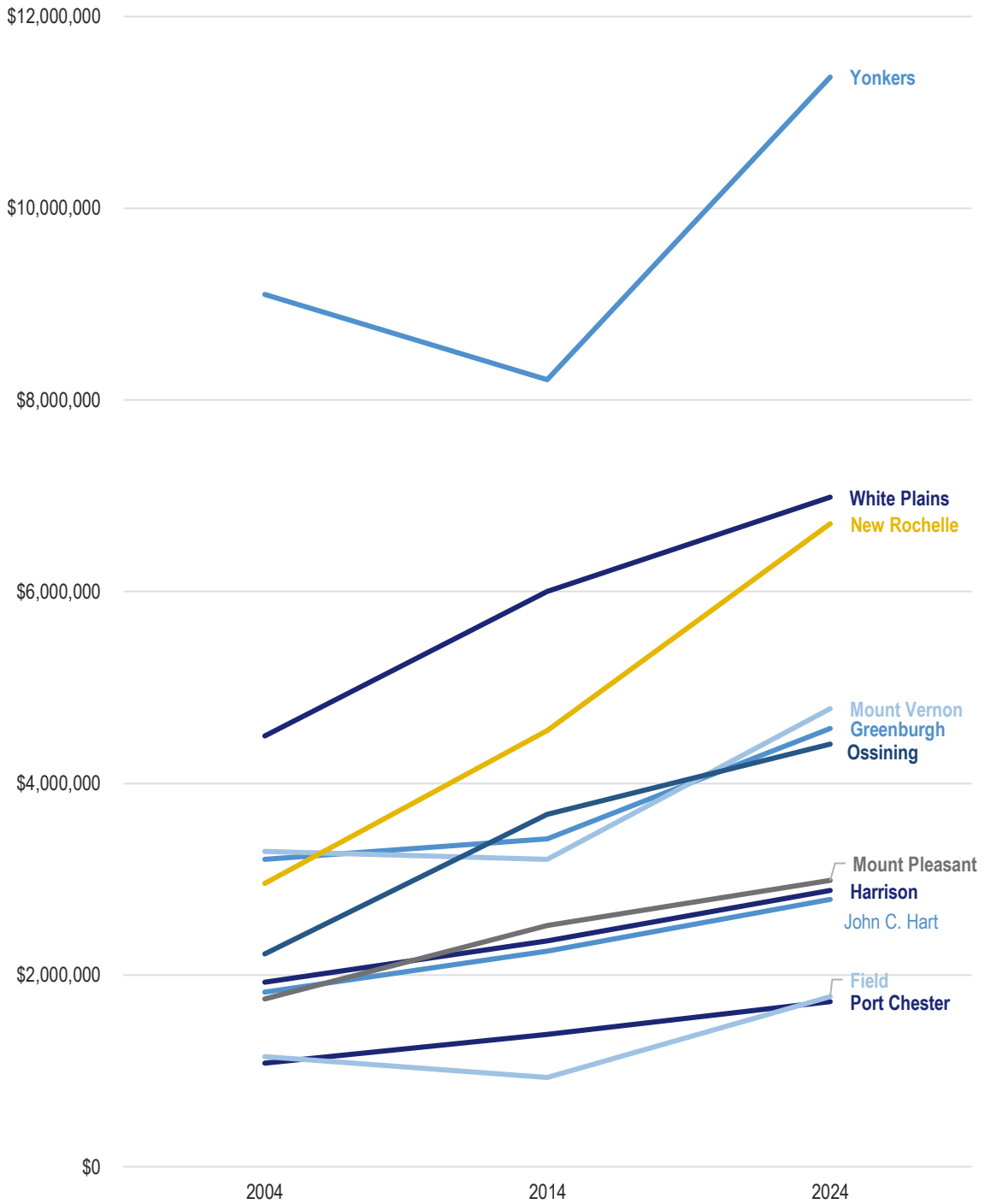

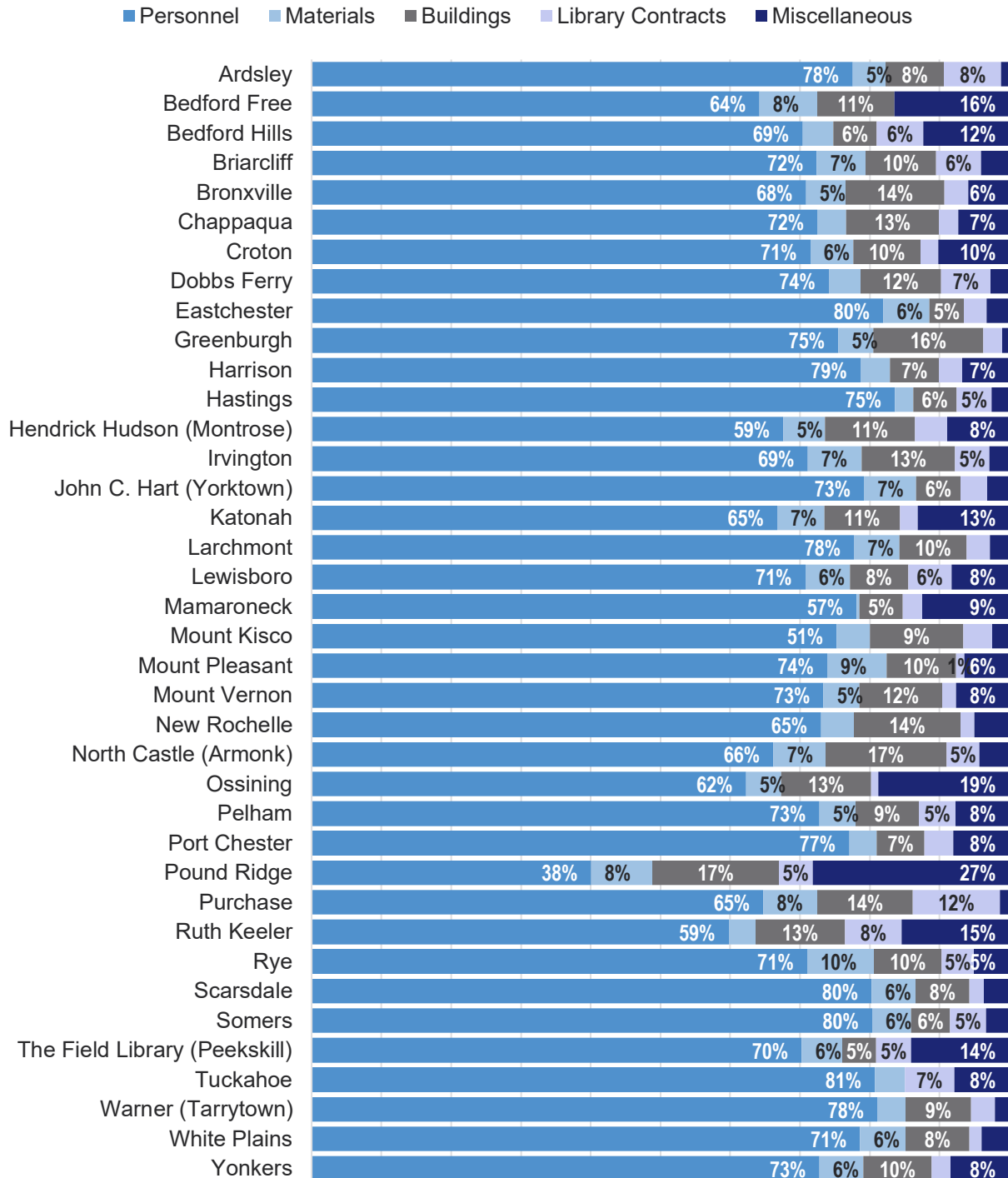

Appendices

Explanatory Notes

Change in Collections Reporting

In 2024, New York State, at the direction of the federal Institute of Museum and Library Sciences agency, required that only physical items be individually counted; electronic items were not.

Patron Purge

In 2020, in order to provide continuing service to patrons during the pandemic restrictions, WLS temporarily suspended library card expirations. The practice resumed in 2024, including a purge of expired and inactive library cards. This resulted in a significant reduction in the number of cardholders at most libraries.

Notes of Unusual Circumstances

The Briarcliff Manor Public Library reported that the Children's Librarian had to suddenly go on leave due to illness. We were unable to hire a replacement for her because she qualified for paid leave. We did not have the funds to both pay her leave and hire a replacement. We did our best putting together the most amount of programming that we could.

Access to the Bronxville Public Library was limited to the front entrance for roughly 6 months of the FY23-24 due to the construction of a large outdoor patio. Additionally, parking capacity was reduced during the time as well.

The Eastchester Public Library continued to operate as two major projects continued into 2024. Efforts to stop the flow of outside water into the building was not completed until fall when the library was able to replace its passenger elevator. The elevator, which was out of service for over 2 1/2 years, was finally put back in service the second week of 2025. This was a great inconvenience to patrons who were directed to enter the library by walking to the far side of the building where a handicapped ramp was installed.

The West Harrison Branch was closed from August 26 to September 10 due to a sewage backup.

The Katonah Public Library's two full time librarians left in 2024, and the library experienced a period without a full-time Children's Librarian. During this transitional period, the newly hired librarians required time to acclimate to their roles, impacting collection development and programming.

The Armonk location of the North Castle Library started construction on the main support Truss on October 16, 2023. This was ongoing until April 15, 2024. The public did not have access to the library's adult reading and reference area, children's, and teen areas. Limited access to the collection was available to the public during this time.

The departure of the Purchase Free Library Director in Sept 2024 required that the library focus on priority day-to-day operations rather than pursuing new programming, development, etc.

The Ruth Keeler Memorial Library conducted a massive weeding program.

Tuckahoe Public Library was closed for renovations and did a massive weeding of the collection. Library reduced hours from November 1, 2023, and then closed for the public on November 15, 2023, and opened in January 2024.
